SUBJECT: September 2017 Drug Testing Statistics

The rate of positive results from drug testing of adult arrestees for September 2017 increased by 2% when compared to last month, with an overall positive test rate of 31%. Multi-drug positives and heroin each revealed a 1% increase. Synthetic cannabinoids increased by 4%. Cocaine and amphetamines remained consistent. Opiates and PCP decreased by 1% and 2%, respectively.


